Sign-up sheets for Breakfast with Santa

Tony Bruno gave some info advise on how to store your bike for the winter, store in a warm dry place, put on a battery tender or take the battery out, change your oil, don't put in bright sunlight unless its covered, the sun will fade the paint. Put dryer sheets around the seat, and battery cables. If you are still riding be careful of leaves, turkeys, deer. Also stuff your exhaust pipes with muffler plugs or fine steel wool sprayed with WD-40. Be safe and don't fall on your ass on the ice when you're going out to check on your bike.

Frank added that be careful on the newly painted lines or arrows when the mornings are cooler and there is moisture on the road because they can be slippery
