Hand Signals

Road Captains during our group rides will use hand signals to control and communicate with the group. Riders need to become familiar with these hand signals and their meanings. When you see anyone in front of you use a hand signal, it is very important that you relay the signal to those behind you. Everyone in the group must do this except for the last person in the group (known as the Sweeper).
