# Motorcycle Tips from the Safety Officer – Tony Bruno

With riding season just around the corner you will want to check your motorcycle. If something is wrong, you'll want to know about it before you ride.

**Tires:** While walking around your motorcycle take a good look at your tires. Check the tread and the pressure.

Fluids: Check oil and fuel levels. Look under the motorcycle for an oil or gas leak.

**Headlight and Taillight:** Check both. Test your dimmer to make sure both high and low beams are working.

Brake Light: Try both brake controls, make sure each one turns on the brake light.

Coolants and Hydraulic Fluids: Check weekly.

Clutch and Throttle: Make sure they work smoothly.

**Mirrors:** Clean and adjust both mirrors.

**Brakes:** Check front and rear brake levers, one at a time. Make sure each one feels firm and holds the motorcycle when the brake is fully applied.

**Horn:** Try the horn making sure it works.
