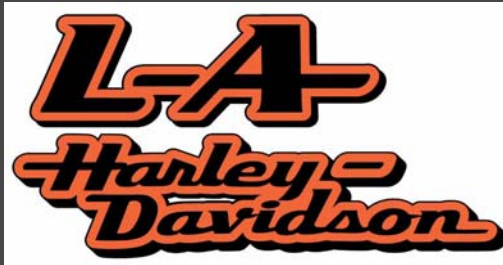
Chapter Events/News
