### Motorcycle Tips from the Safety Officer - Tony Bruno

- Motorcycles have the same rights and privileges as any other vehicle on the roadway.
- Allow your motorcycle a full lane 2width. Although it may seem as though there is enough room in the traffic lane, remember your motorcycle needs room to maneuver safely.
- Always signal your intentions before changing lanes or merging with traffic which will allow you to anticipate traffic flow and find a safe lane position.
- Always make a visual check for traffic by checking mirrors and blind spots before entering or leaving a traffic lane or intersection.
- 8Proceed with caution when approaching a vehicle with flashing turn signals as people sometimes forget to turn them off.
- Remember road conditions can pose a hazard such as potholes, gravel, wet/slippery surfaces, pavement seams, railroad crossings and grooved pavement. You may need to adjust speed and lane position.
- Remember to follow the rules of the road ~ red lights, stop signs, and emergency vehicles.
