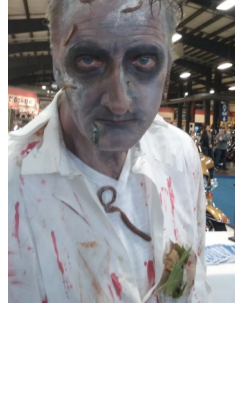
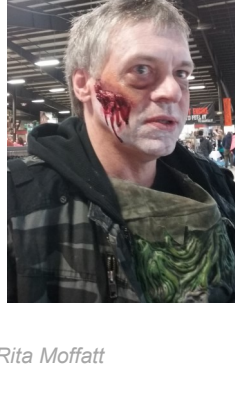
And the amazing weather continues!! 60° in Maine in the month of November—gotta love it! Will it continue into December? Let's hope so!
