Motorcycle Tips from the Safety Officer - Tony Bruno

Motorcycle Safety Information

Motorcycles have the same rights and privileges as any other vehicle on the roadway.

Allow your motorcycle a full lane width. Although it may seem as though there is enough room in the traffic lane, remember your motorcycle needs the room to maneuver safely.

Always signal your intentions before changing lanes or merging with traffic which will allow you to anticipate traffic flow and find a safe lane position.

Always make a visual check for traffic by checking mirrors and blind spots before entering or leaving a traffic lane or intersection.

Proceed with caution when approaching a vehicle with flashing turn signals as people sometimes forget to turn them off. Remember road conditions can pose a hazard such as potholes, gravel, wet/slippery surfaces, pavement seams, railroad crossings and grooved pavement. You may need to adjust speed and lane position.

Remember to follow the rules of the road ~ red lights, stop signs, emergency vehicles. Ride safe..
